### NOTICE OF RACE

#### 1. RULES:

**1.1** This event will be governed by the rules as defined in the Current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS). The prescriptions of the Canadian national authority, Sail Canada, will apply. **1.2** In case of differences between the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions will apply.

#### 2. ELIGIBILITY:

**2.1** The Easter Seals Regatta is open to all boats.

**2.2** Boats may enter by completing the online registration form available at [www.EasterSealsRegatta.org](http://www.EasterSealsRegatta.org)

**2.3** The following restrictions on the number of boats apply: 50 participants for the Race, no restriction on the Easter Seals Harbour Cruise.

**2.4** Participants may choose to enter the race or the cruise. **All competitors must have a Valid PHRF Certificate.** If a competitor does not have a PHRF certificate than a PHRF rating will be assigned.

#### 3. ENTRY AND FEES:

**3.1** The Organizing Authority must receive the completed online entry form by Saturday, August 18, 2018 at 1200hrs.

#### **5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:**

**5.1** The sailing instructions will be available after Tuesday, August 7<sup>th</sup>, 2018 at 1200hrs on the RCYC website.

#### **6 VENUE:**

**6.1** The Easter Seals Regatta will be hosted from the Royal Canadian Yacht Clubs Island Facility. A ferry from 150 Cherry Street runs to the Island at quarter to and quarter past the hour. **6.2** Fleet Racing shall be held inside the harbour.

**6.3** The Cruising Race shall start and finish in the harbour but may include the outer harbour and the lake.

#### **7 SCORING:**

**7.1** The Low Point System, RRS Appendix A will apply.

**7.2** All boats shall be assigned a PHRF

#### **8 BERTHING:**

**8.1** Boats shall be kept in their assigned places while they are in the Club.

#### **9. PRIZES AND AWARDS:**

**9.1** Prizes will be given as follows: 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place finishers as well as any other prizes the organizers deem deserved.

#### **10. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY:**

**10.1** Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

#### **10 INSURANCE:**

**10.1** Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$2 000 000 CAD per incident. A copy of the policy shall be kept on board.
